

## How to Become a Licensed REALTOR® in Louisiana

## **License Requirements**

Here is a helpful pre-license checklist provided by the Louisiana Real Estate Commission: LREC Pre License Check List

## **Overview:**

- You must be at least 18 years of age.
- You must have obtained a high school diploma or equivalency certificate (GED).
- You must show proof of successful completion of ninety (90) hours of real estate education in courses approved by the LREC.

- You must comply with all application procedures required by the LREC.

  - Application Part B
- You must pass the real estate salesperson licensing examination.
  - Louisiana Real Estate Commission and Louisiana Appraisers Board Candidate Handbook
- You must be supervised by a licensed real estate broker and provide proof of errors and omissions insurance prior to license issuance.
